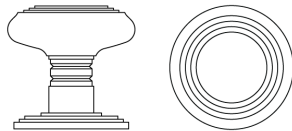




No 1006

The No 1006 knob was inspired by an American Art Deco design of the 1930s. A slight outward flaring of the bullnose edge softens the strict geometry of the stepped face. The knob is adaptable to a variety of interiors, depending on the choice of finish; polished nickel, satin nickel and chrome emphasize the modernity of the design, while burnished brass and patinated finishes portray a more traditional appearance. The knob may be provided in 2", 2-1/4", 2-1/2", and 3" diameters for doors, and the No 8006 [cabinet](#) knob is available in 3/4", 1", 1-1/4", 1-1/2", and 1-3/4" diameters. Roses for cabinet knobs are available at an additional cost. Full mortise entry locks, privacy locks, passage latches, as well as tubular latches may be provided for use with this knob.
