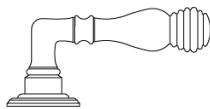
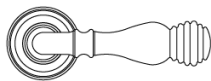




No 2535

The No 2535 lever is derived from Baroque designs popularized throughout the new world in the 18th century. Its classic profile has been streamlined and updated, featuring a complex terminus adorned with rapidly undulating compound curves. While this lever is suitable for traditional interiors, unconventional [finishes](#) like burnished nickel can adapt it to more eclectic environments. The handle can be used with full-mortise locksets or manufactured for use with multi-point doors and tilt & turn windows. A variety of alternative rose designs may be specified, and all Nanz plated and patinated finishes are available.
