


Nº 6157

The N^o 6157 thumblatch pull is based on 18th century design, with leaf-shaped terminals and a bow handle. As the thumblatch is depressed, the connected bar passing through the door raises a pivoting cross bar, disengaging it from a latch attached to the door frame. The thumblatch extends through the door and engages a pivoting bolt. The handle is also available with rounded terminals as the N^o 6767. All nanz plated and patinated finishes are available.
