The face of the No 8003 Georgian cabinet knob is broken by a series of steps, diminishing to a cavetto with a boss at the center. The repeated outward curves of the knob are balanced by the cove profile of the shank. The well proportioned knob is appropriate for a variety of styles and periods and is shown here with and without an optional rosette. It is often specified with the companion \underline{No} 1003 knob, which is manufactured in a variety of sizes for full-sized doors. All Nanz plated and patinated $\underline{finishes}$ are available.
