 $The \ No\ 8204B\ cabinet\ knob\ was\ of ten\ used\ in\ Neoclassical\ Park\ Avenue\ apartment\ buildings\ of\ the\ 1920s.\ It\ is\ provided\ in\ four\ sizes.$ A beaded knurl complements the ogee face and torus edge of the knob, which is also available with a roped or plain astragal. The shallow cove of the shank is echoed in the edge of the optional rosette , which is available at an additional cost. It is often specified with the companion No 1204 knob, which is manufactured in a variety of sizes for full-sized doors. All Nanz plated and patinated finishes are available.
