The No 8305R Georgian cabinet knob has streamlined its more bulbous, 18th-century prototype. Refined moldings and a roped astragal within a shallow step adorn the updated knob. A cavetto molding at the base of the shank forms a transition to the optional rosette with an ogee profile ringed by a roped astragal, which is available at an additional cost. The classic simplicity of the knob is appropriate for traditional and contemporary interiors. Recommended <u>finishes</u> include burnished brass, polished brass, and polished  $nickel. \ It \ is \ of ten \ specified \ with \ the \ No \ \underline{1305R}. Georgian \ knob, \ which \ is \ manufactured \ in \ a \ variety \ of \ sizes \ for \ full-sized \ doors. \ The \ knob \ and \ a$ is available in five sizes and is shown here with an optional rosette.
