The No 8305R Georgian cabinet knob has streamlined its more bulbous, 18th-century prototype. Refined moldings and a roped astragal within a shallow step adorn the updated knob. A cavetto molding at the base of the shank forms a transition to the optional rosette with an ogee profile ringed by a roped astragal, which is available at an additional cost. The classic simplicity of the knob is appropriate for traditional and contemporary interiors. Recommended [finishes](#) include burnished brass, polished brass, and polished nickel. It is often specified with the No [1305R](#) Georgian knob, which is manufactured in a variety of sizes for full-sized doors. The knob is available in five sizes and is shown here with an optional rosette.
